



Ron's Reflections

At Cornerstone we are undergoing some very exciting changes! Due to the good problem of extremely limited parking spaces because of our growing congregation, our trustees, led by Randall Jones and assisted by Nick Turner have been able to add sixteen additional parking spaces to the parking lot. The expense incurred for limestone and base to create these spaces was immediately covered by several members of the congregation before the work was even accomplished. Thank you and Praise the Lord!

This week, the architect will begin the preliminary drawings for locating the pastor's and administrative assistants' offices downstairs in order to be accessible to people of all ages and abilities. Recently, more painting was completed in the hallway to the fellowship hall. The refrigerator in the kitchen was repaired and the shelves for the food pantry were brought up to code and the shelves were stabilized.

This past week the submersible well and pressure tank needed to be replaced along with the breaker in the electrical panel for the well pump. Leon Coblentz stepped up and made all of that happen in short order! Another shout out to Leon Coblentz is that he has taken it upon himself to upgrade the heating element and circulation pump and switches for the baptistry. This morning we tested the water temperature, and it was nearly 100 degrees! This is exciting to know that we will not have to baptize again in COLD water as we have in the past! Thank you, Leon! Leon also had the water tested and next on the list is a new water softener that will most likely be replaced next week, thus providing clear clean water for the baptisms that we plan to host on Palm Sunday!!

With the beautiful spring weather this week, this morning Randall Jones and I tackled the trees back of the building that needed to come down. The trees came down, there is firewood available to anyone, first come first serve, and as I write this reflection, we are receiving load after load of fill dirt for free from Lake Center to build up the area in back of our building for the new Gaga pit and playground that we hope to install for the children this spring! We estimate the savings of this free dirt from Lake Center Christian School to be about 25000.00! Praise the Lord! God is on Mission, he is providing and the Church is on the Move!

More repairs around the church are on the list as spring arrives and we are excited about tackling them as we have the time! Would you like to help? There's plenty to do for everyone!

Again, a huge shout out and thank you to Randall Jones, Leon Coblentz, Nate Miller as they work in their spare time to tackle some of these bigger jobs that require their knowledge and expertise!
