As I listened to the team share their hearts and testify to the goodness of God, my heart at times felt as if it was going to burst.

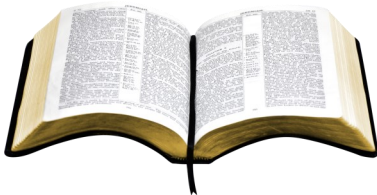
