Clients are eligible for delivery if they are senior citizens, lacking transportation, and live in 44632 & 44685 zip codes. Volunteers that deliver groceries are asked to use their personal vehicles. Volunteers can pickup groceries as early as 9:15am on Tuesday mornings and 5:15 on Thursday evenings. The amount of deliveries varies from 1-4 per driver depending on needs that day. Deliveries are usually able to be completed by 10am Tuesdays and 6pm Thursdays. 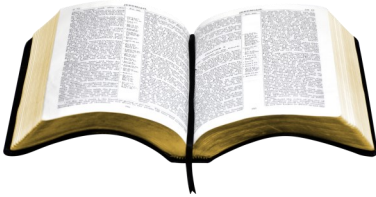

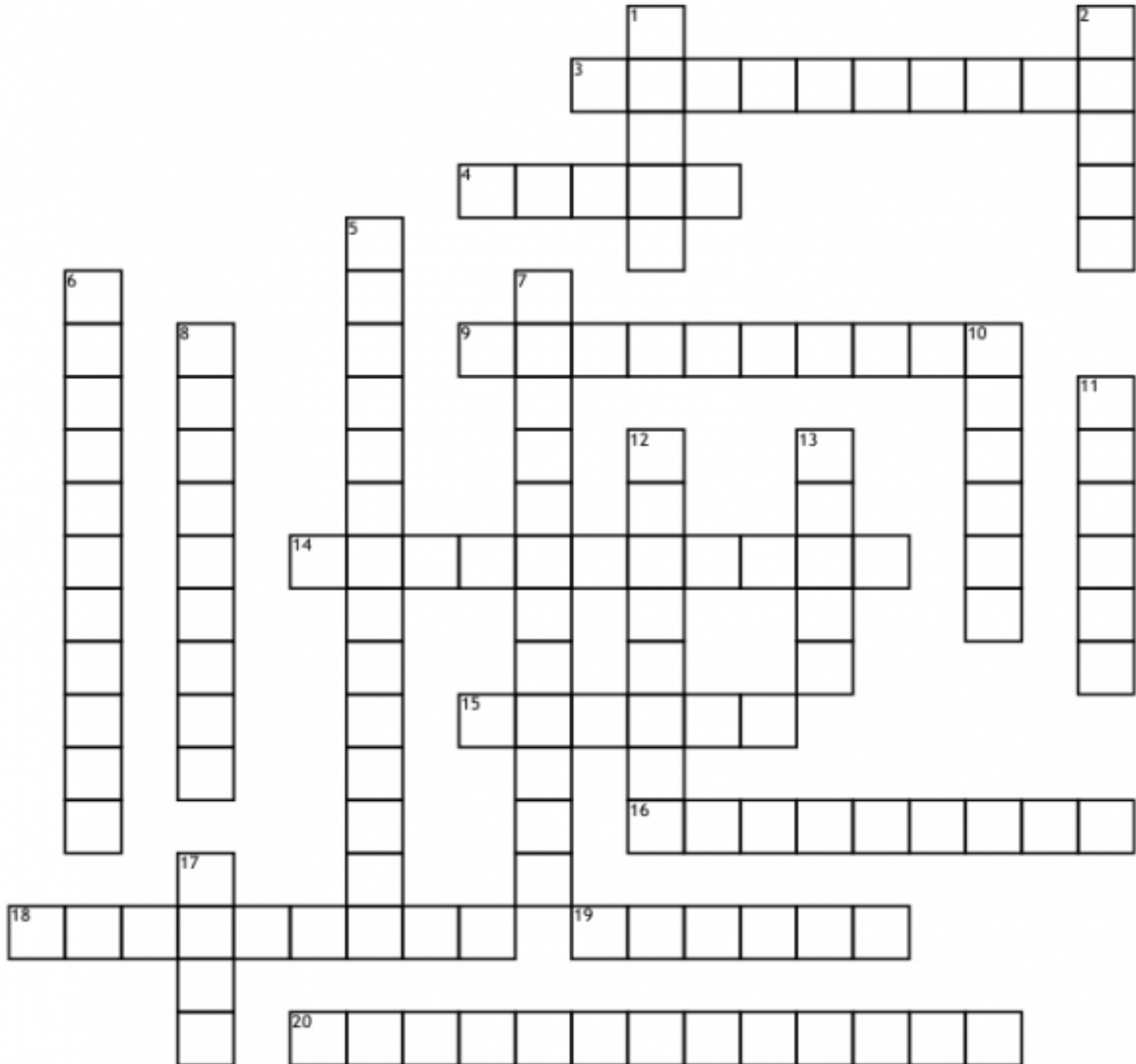
