# RON'S REFLECTIONS

As I reflect on this past weekend, Psalm 133:1a comes to mind. "How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in unity!" Compared to many, I'm new to this area. I have the privilege of not knowing all the actions, the events, the history and the stories that led to the establishment of various churches that are currently scattered throughout the community. I have observed however, that there are many people who are either closely or distantly related that call one of these churches their home.

Since coming to Cornerstone to serve as pastor nearly 7 years ago, we've planned and hosted an annual fall festival in September or the first part of October. The mayor of Hartville has attended our festival numerous times over the years and in the last two years has given us an invitation to consider bringing the fall festival downtown. Last year we considered moving the festival but due to perceived logistical challenges in the end decided that we would have it again in our parking lot at this end of town.

Between three of the churches, we have had in place a collaboration team for several years. The purpose of this team was to explore ways for our churches to work together for the glory of God and to reach our community with the love and message of the Gospel. So, last year the idea of hosting a fall festival downtown was presented to this team and this year the team decided to go ahead and give leadership to bringing the event to fruition.

Several months ago, I was approached to lead this team for several reasons. One, being the fact that I've given leadership to these fall festivals for many years in numerous communities where I was pastoring or planting a church. Secondly, because one pastor was taking a sabbatical and his associate was now tasked with taking his place and could no longer lead the collaboration team. So, with the help of Cornerstone's excellent administrative assistant, Katie Harsh, we set out to bring together four local churches to serve in hosting "Harvest in the Village" festival on September 14th. These four churches are: Cornerstone, Bethany, Evermore and New Life Church.

Realizing that we were no longer in our own parking lot but would be taking over downtown for this 4-hour event, I began to build vision around the question: "Since we are called to be a blessing, how can we be a blessing to those who are permanent residents and merchants of the down town area of Hartville?" We chose to meet with them and ask them what the common headaches are when events that close the street down are held in their neighborhoods. The merchants candidly shared and we began to devise a plan accordingly.

For any of you who were not able to attend the event that was held this past Saturday, let me just say that "Harvest in the Village" was a huge success! According to Mayor Cindy Billings and many others, we were a delightful blessing! We anticipated two to three thousand people attending and that is about how many who came. There was plenty of food to go around and there were many volunteers from the 4 churches who served in a multitude of ways from set up to tear down, to singing on stage, praying for people in the prayer tent, to serving food, drinks and ice cream to helping children paint pumpkins to painting their faces. Other activities offered were barrel train and hayrides, a bounce house, a dunk tank, hand drawn caricatures and more. There were many things for parents to do with their children. A huge shout out also to the fire and police departments for bringing touch a truck and a K9 demonstration.

Jesus commanded his followers to "love your neighbor as yourself." On Saturday we got a true glimpse of what it looks like when followers of Jesus, walk together in humility and unity to love their neighbors as themselves. When this happens, we become blessers that are also vessels of God's richest blessing to us, his love and the good news of the gospel of Jesus, shared with our neighbors and strangers who then become friends for the glory of God and the exaltation of Jesus. A huge thank you to all who served to make this happen. How sweet it is when we all walk together in unity! Love ya!


