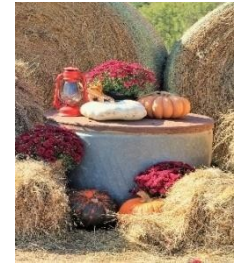
CHILDREN'S MINISTRIES AT CORNERSTONE:

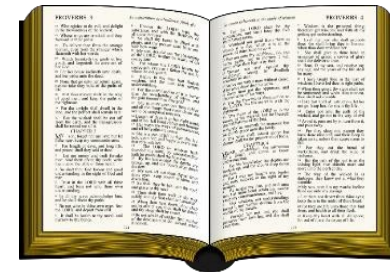
