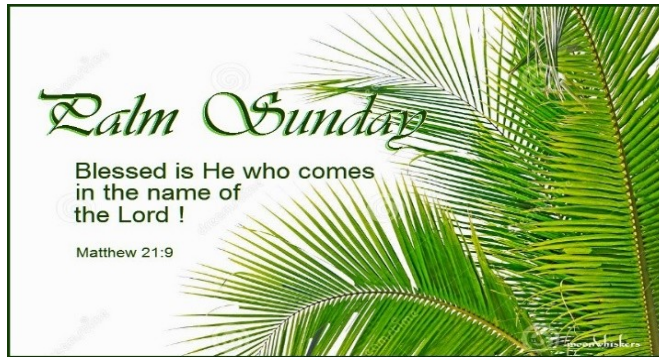


Welcome to Cornerstone Community Chapel
