 - c. **As in the natural, so in the spiritual**

- II. **Multiplication results from intimacy**
 - a. **“Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived...”**
Genesis 4:1
 - b. **As in the natural, so in the spiritual**

- III. **Multiplication requires sacrifice**
 - a. **“Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.” John 12:24**
 - b. **As in the natural, so in the spiritual**

- IV. **Multiplication leads to great joy**
 - a. **“Those who sow in tears shall reap with shouts of joy!”**

 - b. **As in the natural, so in the spiritual**

- V. **Invitation to co-labor with Jesus as He builds His church**

The Whole Armor of God

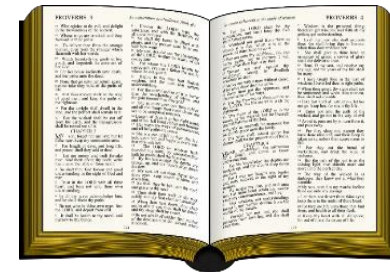
