Prayer

Prayer warriors are needed! Will you take up the challenge?

Plans are being made for our church family to meet in prayer during the day, **Thursday, May 6th**. Specifically: We invite as many of you who can, to arrange your schedules to meet at **12:00 noon on Thursday, May 6th** for a gathering of prayer on the National Day of Prayer.. If you cannot come at noon, come anytime during the day and spend some time praying. The church will be open.

A calendar for the week of May 2-8 is on the bulletin board. We are asking you to **sign up** to commit to prayer during that week. **Let’s cover our church and community with 24-hour prayer for the entire week!** Are you willing to set aside an hour or two to pray? If you cannot set aside that amount of time, concentrate on praying as you mow the lawn, wash dishes or drive in your car, etc.

This year, 2021, National Day of Prayer is Thursday, May 6th. In addition to praying for **our country** and our **world**, let us be specific in our praying by using:

1. Prayers of Confession
2. Prayers of Praise and Gratitude
3. Prayers for God’s Kingdom
4. Prayers for Our Church Families and this Community
 - a. Use the church calendar to pray for specific individuals/families
 - b. Use your church bulletin where specific events/plans/friends who need physical healing are mentioned.
 - c. Pray for the leadership of our church, Pastor Ron, Elders, Council
 - d. Pray the scriptures over your family and over this church
 - e. Pray for the possibilities of a building project here at Cornerstone and for the 8-acre property in Ravenna, that God’s Glory may be fulfilled in these projects!
5. Prayers for those suffering and in need
 - a. The homeless
 - b. The hungry
 - c. The unborn in threat of abortion, as well as their parents.
 - d. Orphans and children whose families can’t or won’t care for them
 - e. Widows and the elderly who don’t have love and support
 - f. The sick (physically, emotionally and spiritually)
 - g. The wounded (physically, emotionally and spiritually)
 - h. Those without access to basic needs like clean water, healthcare and education
 - i. Who else is God putting on your heart to pray for today?
